

Festival Camping Tag Information

NOTE - The number on your camping tag **DOES NOT** identify a **site** number. (The number is for tracking the number sold in each Area.) You are **NOT** assigned a **site**, just an Area to camp in.

You must have an official Festival camping tag attached to each camping unit or structure (tents, Class A, B, C RV's and manufactured pick-up truck campers, ALL screen tents, hanging tarp, etc.)

Please decide on your camping AREA before you move to the online order form. The online order form will not save your information if you "back-button" back to this page, and in some browsers, using the back-button could generate a duplicate order. The purchase of a camping tag **DOES NOT** guarantee you a specific camping site, just an specific Area. Squeeze please and share with your neighbor is encouraged!

A = Full and partial hook-up sites

B = Quiet camping

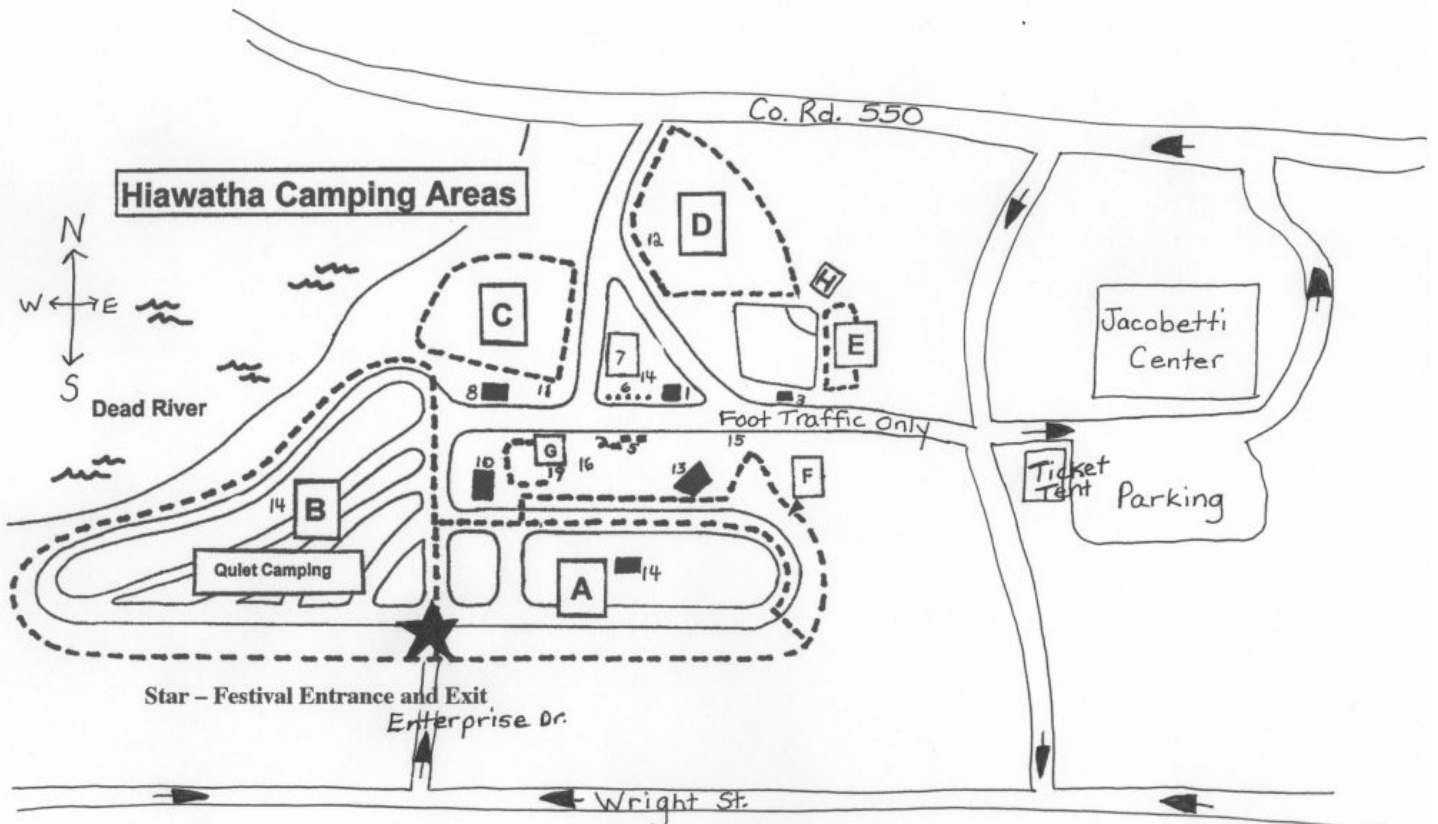
C = Tent only

D = Tents only, drumming allowed until 1am

E = Behind the old Baseball Diamond. Tents or very small campers only

(F = Monitor & Musician Camping Only)

(G = Artist and Vendor Camping Only)



Each camping tag is good for the Friday, Saturday and Sunday nights of the Festival weekend. Owners of untagged camping units discovered during the Festival will have a choice of removing the unit or buying an "emergency" tag for \$30.
