

## Festival Parking information

To park your vehicle in Tourist Park during the Festival, you must buy and display a Festival Parking Pass. Parking passes are available to registered weekend campers only. Purchase your Parking Pass with your Weekend Tickets and Camping Tags. Parking Passes are \$75 and allow you to park at your campsite Friday-Sunday. You must leave the park by 12 noon on Monday. You may exit and enter with your displayed Parking Pass as many times as you need, however, we do recommend that you arrive with what you need. We do not recommend driving in the campsite area at night.

People whose vehicles have official handicap license plates or hang tags are provided with a Parking Pass for free and may park close to the Main Stage. Parking Passes are limited and available first-come, first-served.

Purchase a Parking Pass if you:

- leave your vehicle at your campsite all weekend
- are hauling a tow-behind camper and you keep your vehicle on Festival Grounds
- if you sleep in your vehicle/car/truck/van/motorcycle

### Free off-site parking

You may park free in the Jacobetti Center parking lot directly across from the Tourist Park entrance, and in an overflow lot at the University Service Center just south of the Park on the same side of Sugar Loaf Ave.

Northern Michigan University allows us to use these lots at no charge, so please treat them with respect. Keep all fire lanes and entrances clear. **Do Not park on the grass!!!**

### Free shuttles

A free shuttle will run to and from off-site parking throughout the weekend. Hiawatha has hired a local taxi-cab 6 passenger van and open air trailer (for chairs, coolers, camping gear) that is free to Festival-goers. This shuttle will take you directly to your camping Area.

A free horse-drawn shuttle will run from the Jacobetti parking lot to the Festival grounds during daylight hours.

Please reduce traffic in the Park and save space for camping. If you do not need your vehicle on site, please park in the free off-site parking and use the free shuttles.

We can issue you a temporary parking pass to unload your camping gear.
