All items sold must be original and hand crafted by the young artist. **Please, no kits.**

Parents/Guardians may help their artist set-up and tear down their sales area only. We feel that it is important that the young artists interact with their customers and handle sales independently. Special accommodations can be made when needed. Volunteers will be available to provide assistance.

Artists should bring their own chairs and table coverings, if needed. A four-foot by two-foot space will be provided for each artist.

A schedule will be made for the Young Artist's Corner; artists will be notified in advance about what time they will be selling their wares.
